LIA BOAT APPLICATION FORM

WATERCRAFT REGISTRATION

Your paperwork is to be turned in at the front gate drop box, or mailed to the LIA mailing address. Please allow <u>five days</u> after receipt of your paperwork to process your boat application. If you are a permanent resident, your boat sticker will be delivered by LIA Security. If you are not a permanent resident, your boat sticker will be sent to you in the mail unless you make other arrangements. All boats will be inspected for proper LOT NUMBER on the right bow and transom of the boat.

The information we need to process your paperwork includes:

1. This completed form

SIGNATURE

- 2. Proof of current watercraft LIABILITY INSURANCE in the member's name
- 3. A CURRENT copy of your ILLINOIS (DNR) REGISTRATION
- 4. A copy of the watercraft TITLE in the member's name

Please allow five days to process your boat application. Security will call you for an appointment to physically inspect your boat. You will need three sets of 3" reflective stickers (your lot numbers); two sets for your boat and one set for your boat trailer. Security will show you where to attach these stickers during your boat inspection. Your current Illinoi DNR registration number and decal must be displayed on your boat.

If you fail to put your lot number on your boat trailer and park in the boat ramp parking area, it will be towed. If you intend to keep your boat and/or trailer parked at the designated area for the season please let security know it will be there. It is your responsibility to keep the grass mowed and weeds removed around your trailer.
