

BOAT APPLICATION FORM

BOATS PREVIOUSLY STICKERED

This year, your paperwork is to be turned in at the front gate drop box, or mailed to the LIA mailing address. Please allow five days after receipt of your paperwork to process your boat application. If you are a permanent resident, your boat sticker will be delivered by LIA Security. If you are not a permanent resident, your boat sticker will be sent to you in the mail unless other arrangements are made. The information we need to process your paperwork includes:

1. This completed form
2. Proof of Liability Boat Insurance for 2014
3. An updated copy of your Illinois (DNR) registration

NEW WATERCRAFT REGISTRATION

Turn in the following to the front gate drop box, or mail to the LIA mailing address:

1. This completed form
2. Proof of Liability Boat Insurance for 2014
3. A current copy of your Illinois (DNR) registration

Please allow five days to process your boat application. Security will call you for an appointment to physically inspect your boat. You will need three sets of 3" reflective stickers (your lot numbers); two sets for your boat and one set for your boat trailer. Security will show you where to attach these stickers during your boat inspection. Be prepared to show your **original DNR card** at that time.

If you fail to put your lot number on your boat trailer and park in the boat ramp parking area, it will be towed away. If you keep your trailer parked at the designated area for the season, it is your responsibility to keep the grass mowed and weeds removed around your trailer.
